Records related to the administration of the Lutheran Deaconess Motherhouse and Training School, Baltimore, Maryland, (BMD) comprise the records of this series. There are three record types:

a record book, meeting minutes, and correspondence. The record book is a bound notebook with dated, handwritten entries from 1897-1902 that describe actions taken by, what at that time was referred to as "the direction," the motherhouse's board of management. Examples of entries include assigning deaconesses to parishes, approval of applications for those wishing to enter the diaconate, removing deaconesses from parishes, and recalling deaconesses to the motherhouse. Entries in the book end in 1902, but there is no notation as to why this happened or to where this type of information was relocated. This series also include typewritten meeting minutes for the board of management from two meetings in 1946 and 1948, and meetings from 1950-1962. The remaining record type in this series is correspondence. It is typewritten and dated from 1929-1956. Subject matter includes several letters about the use of the motherhouse grounds by the ULCA's Inner Mission Society for its annual "Lawn Fete;" budget matters and the apportionment allotted by the ULCA for deaconess work; repairs to property; upcoming board meetings; and purchases of equipment and supplies for the motherhouse. The primary author and recipient of this correspondence is Sister Martha Hansen, who served as secretary for the Board of Management. Records date from 1886-1962 and include handwritten and typewritten records, as well as printed material. Record types include correspondence, financial statements, printed reports, orders of service, news releases, bound notebooks, pamphlets, brochures, leaflets, memoranda, sheet music, scrapbooks, circular letters, and printed schedules. Subject matter is varied and includes motherhouse regulations and policies, deaconess garb, donations and memorials, nursing work, anniversaries, triennial programs and observances, merger of motherhouse with Philadelphia Motherhouse of Deaconesses, and promotional material for motherhouse. Within the series there are three subseries related to triennial programs, reports and surveys, and publications and printed material. Two records of note, the notebook titled, "Motherhouse Items and Incidents of the Daily Life" and the nursing visits records book offer a glimpse into the daily workings of the motherhouse as well as the type of nursing work the Baltimore deaconesses performed. Also of interest, the scrapbooks comprise newspaper clippings of timely articles from the earliest days of Lutheran deaconess work in Baltimore. It is in truth a book which has for some years past been wanted. Articles and speeches and Church Congress papers and the like have presented the subject from many points of view during the last

quarter of a century, but since the publication of Dean Howson's volume on 'Deaconess' in 1862, there has, so far as I know, been no serious endeavor to deal consecutively with the early history of the Order, and with its modern revival in the Church of England. The occasion is now ripe. The organized work of women in the Church has of late advanced by leaps and bounds, and the 'apologetic audacity' of Dean Howson's words, as he discusses what women may and may not do, reads today like the utterance of some distant age. Yet the Deaconess life for which he pleaded with persistent earnestness has advanced in the English Church with slow and halting steps, while Sisterhoods, to our inestimable gain, have multiplied and spread on every side. In at least one chapter of this book, an attempt is incidentally made to explain the anomaly. There are bound and unbound copies that date from 1891-1944. Printed in Rock Island, Illinois, at the Augustana Book Concern, this report included lists of board members and committee members; lists of deaconesses; places of service; a historical sketch; summary from the annual meeting; director's report; financial reports, the hospital's annual report, constitutions for the institute, deaconess auxiliary, and deaconess association; the articles of incorporation for the IDI; principles of deaconess work; course listings; and conditions by which deaconess students were received. Annual reports for years after 1944 are found as a monthly issue of the IDI's publication *The Deaconess Messenger*. This series also includes a typewritten translation of the first annual report from the Evangelical Immanuel Association for Works of Mercy delivered in 1890. Care should be taken to minimize the handling of individual reports as the pages are very brittle. This advice applies to those reports in bound volumes as well. This is a combination of my two training manuals: *The Biblical Deacon* and *The Deaconess*. Both are designed to provide training for the church in training men and women for the offices and ministries of Deacon and Deaconess.
