As it covers 2,500 years of political and intellectual history, *Perceptions of Iran* ties together the diverse threads of Iranian experience that have underpinned the country's social and cultural movements, spanning Mirza Agha Khan

Kermani's writing on Persian history and liberal nationalism, through to the strident anti-Western discourses of Seyyed Jamal al-Afghani, Jalal Al-e Ahmad and Ayatollah Khomeini. The book is therefore vital for researchers of Iranian history and those interested in the use of myth in the construction of national identity more widely.
