risk pregnancy diabetes if you have diabetes before you become pregnant you will likely be referred to a maternal fetal medicine pre eclampsia pre eclampsia is a condition unique to pregnancy where you have high blood pressure in conjunction with web dec 6 2022 specific factors that might contribute to a high risk pregnancy include advanced maternal age pregnancy risks are higher for mothers older than age 35 lifestyle choices smoking cigarettes drinking alcohol and using illegal drugs can put a pregnancy at risk maternal health problems high blood web the term high risk pregnancy suggests that in order to have a healthy and successful pregnancy and delivery extra care is needed this is often the case if you suffer from a chronic illness or have other factors and conditions that may put you in web jul 15 2022 the risk of developing high blood pressure during pregnancy is higher research suggests high blood pressure that develops during pregnancy is more common in older age your health care provider will carefully monitor your blood pressure along with your baby s growth and development web may 31 2016 risk factors for a high risk pregnancy can include existing health conditions such as high blood pressure diabetes or being hiv positive 1 overweight and obesity obesity increases the risk for high blood pressure preeclampsia gestational diabetes multiple births the risk of complications web oct 10 2022 conditions and factors that increase pregnancy risk include unmanaged high blood pressure polycystic ovarian syndrome pcos kidney disease thyroid disease autoimmune diseases such as lupus and multiple sclerosis obesity hiv zika virus being a teen being over age 35 smoking cigarettes during
